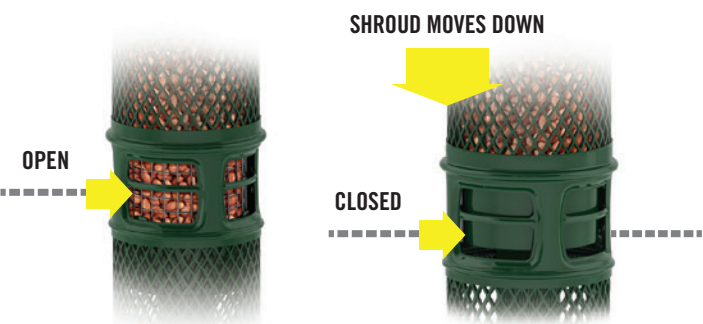




HOW IT WORKS

Openings in the shroud align with the ports, providing birds access to the food. When a squirrel climbs onto the feeder, its weight automatically forces the shroud down, closing access to the ports. Squirrels and some large birds are foiled but not harmed in any way.

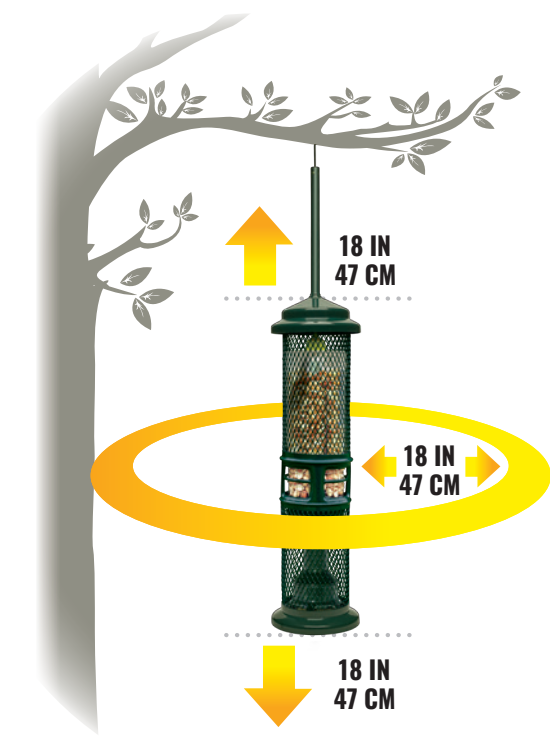

! THE NEED FOR CLEARANCE

Remember it's the squirrel's weight that triggers the closing mechanism. If a squirrel can reach over from a nearby foothold and avoid placing weight on the feeder, it will have access to the seed ports. Allow for at least 18 inches or 47 cm of clearance around the feeder. This will force the squirrel to climb onto the feeder, thus triggering the closing mechanism.



WILD BIRD SAFETY

Landscape with native plants, provide shelter and nesting sites.

5. Keep cats away from birds
6. Reduce window collisions

Reverse steps to reassemble

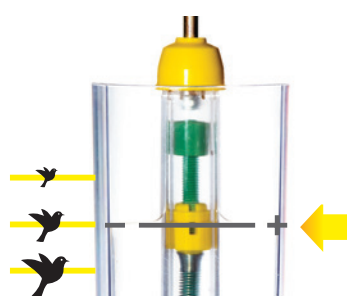


WEIGHT-ADJUSTABLE

Patented weight adjustable spring mechanism controls how much weight the shroud will support allowing the birds to feed. Any additional weight will activate the closing mechanism.

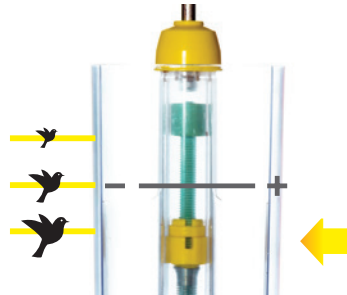
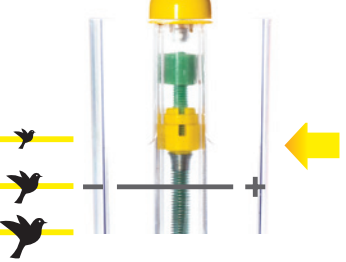
TENSION

To adjust the spring tension rotate the yellow adjustment dial



Factory setting recommended

To Deter Heavier Birds
Rotate the yellow adjustment dial towards the “-” sign.



To Allow Heavier Birds
rotate the yellow adjustment dial towards the “+” sign.



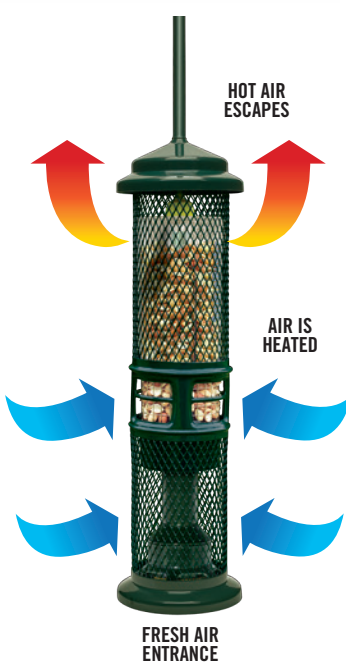

1 Unscrew and remove the tube

Change the meshes

Carefully align the mesh within the 3 green tabs

Slowly screw the tube, ensuring the mesh is inside the upper and lower edges

Cleaning Your Feeder

Your Squirrel Buster® is designed to be easily dismantled for cleaning. Frequency of cleaning varies according to climate. In general, in hot and humid climates, more frequent cleaning is required than in colder climates. Heavy bird traffic can also increase the frequency of cleaning.

⚠ Warning: Bird droppings contain contaminants. Avoid skin contact.

Washing by Hand. Wear Gloves!

Dismantle and discard any accumulation of wild bird food. Wash by hand in warm soapy water and/or in 1/10 bleach solution. Make sure all components are completely dry before assembling.

DETACHABLE COMPONENT SYSTEM™

Squirrel Buster® feeders are designed to be dismantled by hand into individual components without the use of tools. This allows for easy cleaning and filling.



NO MESS NO WASTE®

Birds consume the entire shelled nut or fruit, so there are no shells to accumulate under the feeder. Ideal for decks, condos and apartments.



WOODPECKER-SAFE

Woodpeckers apply a lot of force when pecking at their food. The construction of the feeder absorbs all the force and is not affected by Woodpeckers' continuous pecking.

WOODPECKER FRIENDLY TAIL PROP

The Squirrel Buster® Nut Feeder is designed with a large tail prop allowing woodpeckers to feed comfortably, using their tails for support and balance – just like they do on trees. Woodpeckers have zygodactyl feet, each consisting of four toes, the first and fourth facing back and the second and third facing front. This toe arrangement is good for grasping the limbs and trunks of trees, but to balance easily the tail and feet need to work together for support. Thus, they need a large surface against which to prop their tails.



WHY IS THE NUT FEEDER TUBE SO SMALL?

Nuts can go bad rather fast, especially in humid and damp conditions. They release aflatoxins. These toxins are harmful to both birds and humans. Providing a smaller tube will ensure that nuts are consumed faster without having a chance to spoil.



CHEW PROOF

All feeder parts exposed to squirrels are made of chew proof materials.
